



Inadequate transportation inhibited southern development




Mississippi River flatboat and keelboat


Steamboats became the workhorse of the plantation regime








Steamboats accelerated forced migrations of indigenous people and enslaved people






The government used steamboats to accomplish Indian Removal



Sinking of the *Monmouth*; 1837 – about 300 Creeks died




Steamboats influenced the growth of railroads




RAILROADS, 1850 AND 1860
